Creative Curriculmn – Building Study – 4 weeks long

Week 1 – Objective: What is a building?

Book: <u>The Three Little Pigs</u>

Week 2 - Objective: Who builds it?

Book: Build It From A-Z

Week 3 – Objective: What are buildings made of?

Book: Buildings, Buildings, Buildings

Week 4 – Objective: What happens inside buildings?

Book: The Real Story of the Three Little Pigs

<u>Summary</u>: Children are mesmerized by buildings, large construction equipment and vehicles; and all the resources used to make a building – lets use their curiosity to learn. This study will explain to children how a piece of land turns into the buildings we see today. We will learn about the characteristics of buildings, the people who build them, and the role they play in our community. While learning about this study we will incorporate math, literacy, and art into the lessons. Buildings are all around us, lets use something our students see and discuss everyday and make it a learning opportunity.
