# Curriculum Write Up!

Creative Curriculumn – Ball Study – 4 weeks long

**Week 1** – Objective: Do all balls bounce and roll?

Book: Have a Ball

**Week 2** – Objective: What makes balls move?

Book: Bounce

**Week 3** – Objective: Who uses balls?

Book: Just Like Josh Gibson

**Week 4** – Objective: What are balls made of?

Book: The Three Billy Goats Gruff

Summary: Children LOVE BALLS! This study shows how to use children's interest in balls to help them explore natural forces, the cause and effect of movement, and the change of speed and direction. Our investigation will incorporate indoor and outdoor activities to see why balls bounce, roll and move. We will discuss sports and exercise that use different types of balls and how they are used in each. This study will strengthen our children's skills in literacy, math and gross motor skills. At home you can increase your child's knowledge by playing ball with them – teach them about the styles, shapes and textures. We can use a simple study to learn and teach our children and class so much!
