Creative Curriculumn – Bread Study – 4 weeks long

Week 1 – Objective: What is bread?

Week 2 – Objective: How is bread made?

Week 3 – Objective: What can we make with bread?

Week 4 – Objective: Who works with bread?

We will investigate the characteristics of bread, make predictions about how bread is made and experiment with materials used to bake bread throughout the month.
